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






RECAP 1: BUILDING COMMUNITY RESILIENCE IN REMOTE NORTH AUSTRALIA







Item	Bininj	Australian Bureaucracy
Language	English	Kune/Binninj Kunwok/Rambarranga etc
Authority	From the Dreaming. Immutable	Legislation under constitution. Laws can change
Accountability	To Songmen, Clan Leadership *	To Minister
Fairness	Allocation according to age, skin, totem, Estate	"Equality"
Land Ownership	Inherited with responsibility to manage shared with others	Can be bought and sold
Land Management	Strictly defined by dreaming: "leave the land as you found it".	Determined on basis of content (resources) and ownership
